We know that Melania is a beauty, but what else can we learn about First Lady # 45?

Melania (nee Knauss) Trump was born April 26, 1970 in Novo Mesto, Slovenia, which was then part of communist Yugoslavia. She is a former model, current businesswoman, and third wife of real estate billionaire, President Donald J. Trump.

Her father was a car dealer and her mother a designer of children's clothing. She grew up in a modest home with her younger sister, and later learned that she had a half-brother by her father.

At age sixteen, Melania began modeling and two years later, signed on with an agency in Milan. In her early days of modeling, she worked in Milan and Paris before moving to New York in 1996.

There she gained steady work with well-known photographers and landed in prestigious publications, such as *Harper's Bazaar, Sports Illustrated* swimsuit edition, and *Vanity Fair*.

Melania met Donald Trump at a New York fashion party in 1998. They became engaged in 2004 and married in a lavish Palm Beach, Florida ceremony the following year. Ironically, Hillary Clinton, Donald Trump's presidential opponent, who was then a senator from New York, attended the wedding.

In 2006, Melania gave birth to Baron William Trump, her first child, and her husband's fifth. That same year she also became a United States citizen.

In November 2016, Melania delivered a rare speech on the campaign trail, outlining how the fight against cyberbulling would be a priority for her if she were to become First Lady.

Now that her husband has been sworn in, she is the first

Foreign-born First Lady since Louisa Adams, John Quincy Adams's wife, who was born in London.
