THE NOTORIOUS RBG:

Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg

The recently released documentary, “RBG,” has revived interest in this diminutive Supreme Court Justice, the second woman to serve on the Bench.

Here are some fascinating facts about Justice Ginsburg:

--She was one of only nine women in her class of approximately 500 at Harvard Law School. When she was attending (1956), she was the mother of a 14-month-old baby and was caretaker to her husband, Martin, who was suffering from cancer at the time.

--As an attorney, RBG argued before the Supreme Court six times, five of which resulted in victory.

--She does 20 push-ups a day, and Justice Kagan is now using her trainer.

--Justice Ginsburg and the late Justice Antonin Scalia were good friends, even though they had opposing views. They shared a love of opera.

--Her favorite Constitutional amendment is the 14th, ratified in 1868. It granted citizenship to “all persons born or naturalized in the United States,” which included slaves who had been recently freed.

--Justice Ginsburg, age 85, has no plans to retire at this time.
