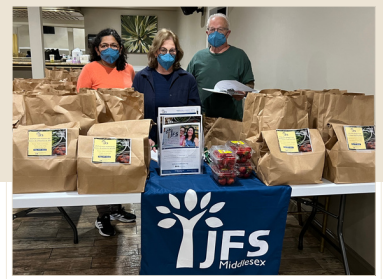




2023 Year End Appeal

- Homebound seniors received tens of thousands of kosher meals and wellness checks.

- Local families took home thousands of bags of kosher food from our food pantries.

With rising food prices, families are struggling and our kosher food pantries are a lifeline to hundreds of all faiths, with more coming to us each week.
